A visit to the restaurant confirms that it debuted yesterday. In the kitchen is Diego Balam, former sous chef at O Bar, who is preparing a hodgepodge menu that focuses on simple,

inexpensive fare. Lunch dishes range from house-cured salmon flatbread (\$6)

to a pulled pork sandwich (\$7), while dinner starts with tomato carpaccio (\$6) and ends with a grilled rib-eye (\$22, the most expensive menu item). The small restaurant is open 7-days a week with a pending beer and wine license.
